3. Minutes of AGM held on 5 Jul 2021	3. The minutes of the last AGM held on 5 July 2021 on Zoom were proposed as an accurate record by Col Ian Sackree and seconded by Col Roger Merryweather. There were no outstanding actions.	
4. Chair's Statement	4. The Chair provided an update on his report which members had been able to read online in advance of the meeting and a copy was included in the Annual Report. There had been various changes in personalities and he welcomed the new CE, Brig Stuart Williams OBE, and new committee members.	
	5. The position regarding the NDPB, ongoing for the last 2-3 years, remained the same, pending identification of the necessary space in the Parliamentary programme to enact the associated legislation. A contextual background, emanating from the Sullivan Report, was provided and it was explained that only a small proportion of the recommendations could be taken forward at the moment that related to the RFCAs. It was therefore anticipated that AGM 2023 would remain the same and perhaps even beyond this depending upon the legislative approval process.	
	6. The Chair expressed his personal thanks to the staff at Triumph Road for their efforts during the pandemic. He made especial tribute to Gp Capt Nick Sharpe for his leadership of EM RFCA during this challenging period and for recruiting new staff in time for his handover, thus providing a solid foundation for the future. He also thanked the volunteer membership and applauded the capacity they provided; to be able to call upon such depth of experience was a remarkable achievement which must be preserved amid the forthcoming transformation.

	<ul> <li>b. The auditors commented that there was a heathy reserve and was within the Grant in Aid limit of 2% and therefore the RFCA was considered as a going concern.</li> </ul>	
	c. There was a healthy RGI due largely to the Covid period which would be used to fund some major cadet projects and actioned over the next few months.

The Scheme of Association required that the Association Board must be given express authority to exercise the Association's statutory powers and duties without prior reference to the membership.</li> </ol>	
	b. <b>Resolution</b> . There was no material change to the powers and duties that the Board currently exercised on behalf of the Association. As a result of the online voting process, the Chair confirmed that the Board had been given its authority by its members to conduct business as usual for the forthcoming year.	
8. To Note Written Reports	11. The Chair expressed his gratitude to the Vice-Chairs, Cadets and Engagement Team for issuing their valuable and informative reports which had been issued prior to the AGM. No questions were raised in relation to written reports which had been tabled and no updates were cited.	
9 &10. Addresses by Guest Speakers	12. Insightful presentations were provided by Brigadier Tim Seal TD ADC DL VR – Deputy Commander (Reserves) 1st (United Kingdom) Division and Commodore Rob Bellfield CBE ADC – Naval Regional Commander London and Eastern England. These presentations focused upon the increasingly important operational role played by Reserves in national Defence capability and the major structural changes, both nationally and regionally, being enacted to facilitate and enhance this. Recent operational examples of effective Reserve activity were provided and the synergistic benefits of Reserves for employers was stressed. The presentations provoked much interest and, subsequently, a number of searching questions were generated and thought provoking answers provided.
